488-X-1-.15 Exemptions

(3) Any person residing outside of the State of Alabama may provide interpreting and transliterating services for up to 14 working days per calendar year without a license. The Board, by passage of a resolution or otherwise, may establish or extend the allowable time in which a person may interpret or transliterate without a license in this state when there is a dire emergency, which would include but is not limited to instances where the governor declares a state of emergency.

To qualify for this exemption, the out-of-state interpreter or transliterator must complete and submit this 14-Day work form for approval by the Board for each assignment.

The notification should be received by the Board's office at least seven (7) days prior to the start of this assignment.
